#### Dillon Reservoir, Denver's Water Collection System

Dillon Reservoir is Denver Water's largest supply reservoir. Here Denver Water collects runoff from mountain snow-pack to store for providing water to approximately 1.5 million people on the Front Range. On this tour you will learn more about the dam, the reservoir and the hydroelectric power at the dam. You will also hear about the history of the dam and reservoir, how they operate today and how Denver Water integrates those operations to meet the recreational and environmental needs in Summit County.
